Nikoniko Club Temporary Childcare Service



☆What is a temporary childcare service?

Our professional staff will temporarily take care of your children according to the needs of the parents/guardians. We provide safe and secure childcare services on a structured program, such as interacting with children from our adjacent childcare center and participating in events.



★ Who is it for?	6 months old to preschoolers (non-town residents are also welcome)
★ Opening hours	Monday-Friday 8:45-16:15 (half day for first time use)
★Our activities	We provide safe and secure childcare based on a structured program that includes interaction with our preschools and participation in events.
★Fees	<p>★Pre-registration is required. 1,800 yen for a full day (less than 8 hours), 900 yen for a half day (less than 4 hours) *Half-day use is subject to the town's regulations. Additional fees: Lunch 400 yen, snack 100 yen, diaper disposal fee 20 yen Cancellations made after 5:00 p.m. the day before will incur a cancellation fee.</p>

Smile - Daytime Temporary Support Room for Children with Severe Disabilities



What is Smile...

We provide temporary daytime support services (daytime care) for children with disabilities who are highly dependent on medical care (cannot live without medical care) to make their lives in the community as easy as possible. The more severe the disability and the larger the number of tubes, the more limited the facilities and services available to take care of these children. As a result, the family members are forced to bear a tremendous burden. The families of children with disabilities face more hardships than we can imagine. These children are unable to move their limbs freely, require sputum aspiration, and need to be watched 24 hours a day. Our goal is to reduce the burden on these families as much as possible, and to create a society in which children with disabilities who are highly dependent on medical care and their families do not have to feel that their lives are difficult.



★ Who is it for?	0-18 years old children with severe mental/physical disabilities
★ Opening hours	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday / 10:00-16:00 *When the clinic is temporarily open on Thursdays, we will also be open.
★ Fees	1,800 yen for a full day (less than 8 hours), 900 yen for a half day (less than 4 hours) *Half-day use is subject to the town's regulations. Additional fees: Lunch 400 yen, Snack 100 yen, Diaper disposal fee 20 yen Cancellations made after 5:00 p.m. the day before will incur a cancellation fee.
★ What to bring	Clothing: Change of shirt, pants, diapers, etc. Meals: Fluid diet, infusion set, medications, etc. Equipment: Suction device, respirator, battery, etc. Others: Cushions, baby stroller, wheelchair, etc.
★ About meals	The adjacent Genki Yume Childcare center has a kitchen where homemade school lunches and snacks are served to the children every day. We hope to alleviate the burden of the families, and we will make every effort to ensure that our meals are safe and reliable for the children who use our services. We will provide school lunches and snacks with textures (mushed, chopped into small pieces, etc.) according to the needs of the children. We hope that we can support your child on the dietary aspects as well. If you would like such support, we will discuss this with our nutritionist before making a decision.

Ichibanboshi Postnatal Care Center



Social Welfare Corporation Kenkinkai, in cooperation with Genki Kids Clinic, has opened a postnatal care center, Ichibanboshi. Like the first star in the night sky, we hope to be a place that radiates brightness to families caring for children. We hope to build a relationship with everyone so that we can all enjoy raising children together.



★ Who is it for?	Those who have been postnatal for up to one year
★ Our activities	Securing rest, breastfeeding care, care for minor postnatal problems, parenting counseling, dietary counseling by dietitian, physical measurements, meeting with users of the Child Support Center
★ Opening hours	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday 10:00-16:00, generally 2 groups/day Bookings can be made by e-mail, so please check our website for availability.
★ Fees	★ Prior application is required. *Subsidies are available for Minami-Alps, Kofu, and Chuo Cities. Fee: 14,000 yen (subsidies are available from some municipalities) Lunch: 500 yen for adults, 300 yen for children Baby food and allergen free meals are available. Please indicate meal type, food allergies, etc. when applying. *Siblings can be taken care of in the temporary childcare service (Registration is required for each fiscal year). Please reserve a space via the Temporary Care Reservation Form on our website. Please visit our website for more details.
★ What to bring	Maternity Handbook, items needed for care, drinks, diaper set, change of clothes, etc.
